

Covid19 Procedures and Entry for Centralia High School

- Students will enter through the main front doors or back parking lot doors. Bus drop off will be at the main entrance (front doors). Parents may drop students off at the main entrance or back door. Doors open at 8:00am.
- Temperatures will be checked at each entrance. If the student's temperature is over 100.4, students will be given a 2nd temperature check after 5 minutes.
- Students will self-report any symptoms at the same time as the temperature check.
- Students with a temperature above 100.4 or self-reported symptoms will go to an isolation area to meet with the COVID specialist.
- The COVID specialist will determine the course of action based on the COVID protocols.
- The COVID specialist is responsible for documenting, reporting, contacting parents, giving literature to the parents, informing school personnel, and all other COVID related issues.
- Students WITHOUT a temperature and NO self-reported symptoms may pick-up a breakfast and take it to their 1st hour classroom.
- Students with athletic equipment or music instruments may take them to their coach or sponsor's classroom on their way to first hour class.
- The cafeteria will keep student lunchboxes for those that bring their lunch.
- Students will eat in the classroom with their 4th hour teacher. Larger 4th hour classes will be separated and moved into empty classrooms or other locations.
- Thursday afternoon students wanting a box lunch for Friday can pick one up on their way to the bus.
- Students on remote learning are expected to turn in assignments on the same day as a student in the classroom.
- Students will be in class Monday through Thursday. Students are responsible for assignments and lessons on Friday.
