

## September 30, 2020

After heavy consideration and much debate, here is the plan for the next two weeks. I completely understand this is NOT ideal for any of us, especially our students, but hopefully the best decision out of several bad alternatives.

Due to the recent increase in the number of positive Covid cases and quarantines, we will "voluntarily" shut In-person Learning down starting tomorrow (September 30) through October 8.

### **Wednesday, September 30 through Friday October 9**

- 1) Teachers are required to be at school during regular school days unless on quarantine.
- 2) Remote Learning will take place for ALL students during this time.
- 3) Friday, October 9 is the last day of the 1st quarter.
- 4) In season sports may continue to participate and practice.
- 5) Out of season sports may continue with voluntary practices.
- 6) Marching Band may continue to practice and participate.
- 7) Breakfast and lunches will be prepared and delivered by bus as in the past.
- 8) **Since this is a "voluntary" shut down, students may come to school and work in the classroom during this time.**
- 9) **Students wanting to start Remote Learning for the 2nd quarter must sign and return the Remote Learning Contract. The form is on the school's web page. If they are already a full time Remote Learner, they need to contact the guidance office to continue full time Remote Learning.**

### **Monday, October 12 - NO SCHOOL, Columbus Day**

### **Tuesday, October 13 - Remote Planning Day**

Teachers only, NO students or assignments.

We will deliver double meals for both Tuesday and Wednesday.

### **Wednesday, October 14 - PSAT/SAT Day**

Juniors and Seniors ONLY in attendance.

NO freshman or sophomore attendance or assignments.

We will have breakfast, snacks, and bagged lunches available for students to take home.

Tests should be over by 1:30ish.

Buses will run their normal routes.

### **Thursday, October 15 - Normal Full Day**

All students in attendance.

### **Friday, October 16 - Remote Learning Day**

All students

Every Friday through the rest of the semester (2nd Quarter) will be a Remote Learning Day.

***Just a reminder, Jr's and Sr's must be in attendance on October 14. Sr's must take the SAT in order to graduate this school year.***
