

Dr. Shipley's Announcement Regarding Remote Learning - Week of 11/2/2020

Due to a substantial increase in the number of students and staff on quarantine, we will have a voluntary school shut down after today. The shutdown includes this Wednesday and Thursday, November 4th and 5th. Remember tomorrow, November 3rd, is a holiday with NO lessons or assignments. We will return to In-Person Learning on Monday, November 9th.

We will utilize the same meal delivery schedule as before. We will deliver 3 days (Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday) worth of lunches on Wednesday.

School offices will be closed Thursday and Friday for cleaning and disinfecting.

Due to the overwhelming need for donations, we WILL continue with the blood drive as planned for Thursday. Everyone, including students, are welcomed to come to the school on Thursday to donate blood. The only entrance/exit will be from the back parking lot through the ticket booth entrance of the gym.

During this shutdown, students will not be able to come to CHS on Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday except to donate blood on Thursday.
