

# Student Computer and Internet Usage Centralia High School District #200

Items in parentheses refer to Acceptable Use Policy.

The student agrees to the following while in attendance at CHS:

- Will comply with the Acceptable Use Policy (A2)
- Computers will be used for purposes of research and for class assignments (A1) (C6a)
- Will not purchase or provide services or products through the Internet (A3)
- Will not use Internet for political lobbying, but may express an opinion to elected officials (A4)
- Follow directions given by supervisor in classroom, lab, library (B1)
- Assigned E-mail accounts may be used for class projects under supervision of a teacher (B2)
- Not to identify him/herself by name, age, sex, telephone number or location over the Internet (C1a)
- Not to reveal another person's name, age, sex, telephone number or location over the Internet (C1a)
- Not to agree to meet someone you meet online without you parent's approval and participation (C1b)
- Will tell your teacher or other school employee if you receive an inappropriate message or one that makes you feel uncomfortable (C1c)
- Will not use the Internet to engage in any illegal act (C2c)
- Not to vandalize the computer systems: harm or destroy data or programs, hacking, introduce viruses into the system, abuse or damage hardware, etc. (C2a,b, C3b,c)
- Passwords are confidential and must not be shared. System or school administrators will have access to all user accounts, including personal directories and e-mail. (C3a)
- Not to use obscene or abusive language or materials (C4a,b)
- Will not post information that could cause damage or disruption, will not engage in personal attacks, or harass another person (C4c,d,e,f) (C5b)
- Will not repost a message that was sent to you (C5a)
- Not to download excessive information without supervision of teacher or librarian or to monopolize resources (there may be time limits to computer/Internet usage in the library.) (C6b)
- Will not post chain letters or engage in "spamming" (C6c)
- Will delete files from assigned account on a regular basis and if assigned a school e-mail will promptly delete unwanted messages (C6d)
- Not to sign up through the CHS Internet facilities for any clubs, listservs, mail lists, or Internet chat (C6e)
- Not to plagiarize and will observe all copyright laws (C7a, b)
- Not to use the Internet to access material that is profane or obscene (pornographic), that advocates illegal acts, or discrimination towards other people (hate literature) (C8a)
- Tell your teacher, librarian, or other district employee if you mistakenly access inappropriate information or find a security issue – this will protect you against a claim of intentionally accessing an inappropriate site (C6b, C8b)
